Pandit Laxmi Kanta Maitra. This College then started functioning at the Kharjala Garden House, a two storied building of Sri Atal Behari Moitra with its initial number of forty-eight students. This arboreal centre of knowledge has now flowered in various fields of Humanities, Basic Sciences and Commerce. In the session 2011-2012, the College has 15 departments and catering to the needs of 5243 students.

The College has been affiliated to University of Kalyani since 2000. The proper guidance by the qualified staff of the College always helps the students to pursue their different degree courses. The College has its own NCC units with firing range for both boys' and girls'; NSS unit, a gymnasium, a vast playground; an open air theatre and an attractive wide garden consisting of several teak and mango trees. Physics department of Santipur College offers Physics Honours (since 1973) and Physics General courses. The striking features of this department are that there are eight full time teaching posts and spacious laboratories (separate labs for General and Honours students). There are separate labs for conducting experiments on optics and electronics. 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FACILITIES EXTENDED TO THE STUDENTS

LIBRARY

1. At present the Central Library of the College has more than 26 000 titles
2. The College library, in general, remains open from 10 30 a.m. to 4 30 p.m. from Monday to Friday and 10 30 a.m. to 1 30 p.m. on Saturday
3. Bonafide College students will be issued library cards and they can have access to the library as per established rules and regulations framed by the College
4. A student can avail the reading room facility on submission of his/her library card to the College library.
5. Each student is provided with a Lending Card for borrowing books. Books can be borrowed for a maximum period of 15 days beyond which Re- 1/- per day would be charged as fine
6. Borrowed book(s) has to be replaced by the borrower if it is found with torn or missing pages or damaged/defaced in any form. Students are advised to check the condition of the book(s) prior to borrowing.
7. Disregard of Library rules, indiscipline and misconduct will render students liable to be denied access to the library.
8. Students can prepare themselves for different competitive examinations of State & National level using this library facility.
9. Besides this central library facility, most of the departments run departmental library and the departmental students can also have their access to this facility.

There are separate capacious well furnished common rooms for both boys and girls for their use during leisure time and for different extramural activities. There are also some indoor game facilities like carom, table tennis etc.

(d) COLLEGE TEAM

The College has a strong team in football, cricket and other games. Our students regularly participate in different sports and athletic meet organized by the University of Kalyani and win prizes and medals in various events. Some of the students also get chance in University team and take part in inter University tournament as well.

STUDENTS' AID FUND AND SCHOLARSHIP

- (1) The very poor and meritorious students of the college are provided help from this fund according to the rules and norms framed by the College and the University of Kalyani.
- (2) *The students who get themselves admitted to self-financing course or enjoy any kind of scholarship, are not entitled to get any help from this fund.*

CULTURAL PROGRAMMES

(a) FRESHERS' WELCOME

The freshers' welcome, organized by the students' union of the College, is a charming annual event where the new comers are given a warm reception by the seniors.

(b) SOCIAL FUNCTION

The social function is also organized by the students' union and this specially admired annual function is the day-long cultural programme by the students. Renowned personalities are also invited to this

programme as special guests. This programme includes debate, singing competition, extempore and other competitions.

(c) SEMINARS / CONFERENCES :

The various departments of the College organize Seminars / Conferences in which the teachers and the students take active part and present papers. Eminent scholars from various fields are invited to give special lectures once in a month.

(d) CULTURAL FUNCTIONS, PLANTATION etc.

The various departments of the College organize debates, extempores, quiz, creative and cultural functions, plantations at different periods round the year.

(e) EXCURSION / EDUCATIONAL TOUR

Many departments like Botany, Zoology, History, Physics etc. organize students' excursion in every year to encourage and explore their ideas in the respective subjects. *The tour expenses are borne by the students participating in the tour.*

COLLEGE MAGAZINE

- (1) The students' union of the College brings out annually a College magazine called 'SUKTI' comprising of thoughts and creative talent of the students. The teachers and staff also significantly contribute to the magazine.
- (2) All the departments of the college also bring out wall magazines which reflect the creative bent of mind of the students of respective departments as well as highlight a particular social problem or scientific achievements.
- (3) The Department of English has published a Special Wall Magazine commemorating the 400 death anniversary of William Shakespeare.

EMERGENCY TREATMENT CENTRE

An emergency treatment centre, furnished with basic requirements, has recently been inaugurated and opened for all the students of the College. The College students can avail first-aid treatment at this health centre.

WOMEN'S CELL

Women can pitch in grievances if physically or mentally harassed. The co-ordinators take care of that.

GRIEVANCE REDRESSAL CELL

The college has a grievance redressal cell to take care of the grievance, suggestion, criticisms to improve the academic standard of the College further.

NETAJI SUBHASH OPEN UNIVERSITY (NSOU), SANTIPUR COLLEGE UNIT

- (1) The College has a study centre (G-04) of NSOU since July 2004 which has currently around 800 students.
- (2) The aim of this centre is to reach out to the poor, the deprived and the disadvantaged population. It also caters to the aspirations of the irregular, dropped out students who want to pursue studies.
- (3) The College unit offers courses like PG, BDP, BLIS and different certificate courses.
- (4) This unit functions on Saturday (after the College hours) and on Sunday (the day when the College is closed).

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REASARCH ACTIVITIES : 2015-16

Dr. Amarjit Kundu, Dr. Dipankar Bhattacharyya and Dr. Sanjay Dhara has been conducting Minor Research Projects at Dept. of Mathematics, Dept. of Physics and Dept. of Chemistry respectively. Last year the teachers from the Dept. of Physics (7) Dept. of Chemistry (1), Dept. of Mathematics (4), English (5), History (2) Commerce (2) has published their research papers in International Journals. Most of the teachers of the college participate in National and International conferences regularly. The faculties also edit books and suppliments (Krorpatra & articles) quite regularly.

OPEN AND DISTANCE LEARNING

RULES AND REGULATIONS

(A) General Rules:

1. All the students are accountable to the College authority for their conduct in college.
2. Students should clear their tuition fees within the last day of each month to the College office failing which fine of Rs. 5/- per month will be charged.
3. Timetable will be distributed to the students at the beginning of the academic year
4. As per guidelines of the University of Kalyani students with at least 75% attendance are collegiate. Students with 60% or above attendance but below 75% attendance are non-collegiate and can seat for the University exams on payment of requisite fees. Students with less than 60% attendance are non-collegiate and can't seat for the University exams.
5. Within the College campus all the students must carry their Identity (ID) Card bearing their photographs authenticated by the College authority. In case of loss of student's ID card, duplicate card will be issued only after production of diary no. obtained from local police station and on payment of Rs. 30/- as fine.
6. A student found to damage college property will be severely punished.
7. Smoking is not allowed within the college premises.
8. It is the duty of the students to keep their College campus class rooms clean and tidy. Scribbling on the walls or desks will not be tolerated.
9. Students are directed not to use mobile phones within the class rooms and examination halls
10. Promotion of students to the next higher class will be granted strictly on the basis of the merit.
11. Students absent from the Internal assessments will not be given any other chance

(B) Anti-Ragging Rules

(B) DEDUCTION OF MARKS: 2 % marks from the aggregate as secured by a candidate passing the qualifying examination in a year prior to the current year shall be deducted and the aggregate marks thus arrived will be taken up for consideration.
